AAFP Virtual Conference – Continuing Education (CE) Information

Veterinarians

Veterinarians are able to earn up to 65 hours of Continuing Education (CE) credits.

Technicians/Nurses

Veterinary technicians and nurses are able to earn up to 65 hours of Continuing Education (CE) credits.

ATTENTION: New York-based Veterinarians and Technicians/Nurses

The 2020 AAFP On Demand Continuing Education content meets the requirements for continuing education from the New York State Board of Veterinary Medicine.

Earning CE

Attendees can earn CE credits by viewing recorded sessions and successfully passing a CE Quiz. When finished with a recorded session, you will need to take the CE Quiz which is comprised of at least 5 questions and will require a minimum score of 70% or higher to pass. You will have 3 attempts to successfully complete each quiz. Upon successful completion, your account automatically tracks all earned CE credit hours to include on your CE Certificate.

RACE Approval

The 2020 AAFP Continuing Education Program Number 249-44275 is approved by the American Association of Veterinary State Boards RACE committee to offer CE credits to veterinarians and technicians/nurses. This program has been approved for 65 hours of continuing education credit in regions that recognize RACE-approval.

This RACE-approval is for the categories of:

- Category One: Medical Program
