Mr. Madray is committed to ensuring patients have access to methadone, as well as needed medical and psychiatric services. He has authored or co-authored several publications related to improving the efficiency of and access to treatment. He collaborated with nearby Federally Qualified Health Centers (FQHC's) to ensure that patients have seamless access to primary care in their OTP. Mr. Madray is known for his service, strength, and unwavering dedication to improving lives through compassionate care. He is selfless, humble, and instinctively generous.
