### EDUCATIONAL ACCESS | CME CREDIT CLAIMING

Instructions to access the 2022 Annual Clinical Assembly (ACA) educational video content and to claim continuing medical education (CME) credit commensurate with participation in the activity.

#### EDUCATIONAL ACCESS:

- 1) Visit the 2022 Annual Clinical Assembly website at: <https://www.eventscribe.net/2022/ACA/>
- 2) Click *Login* at the top of the screen and enter your ACOS website username and password. After logging in click *Full Schedule* to browse the program.



- 3) After logging in you will have access to available 2022 ACA session videos. To view the ACA lectures from the homepage of the ACA site, click on the *Full Schedule*. This will take you to the catalog of all the sessions for the 2022 ACA.

**HELP TIP:** Make sure you are logged in. This is confirmed by seeing your name in the upper right-hand corner of the screen. If not logged in, when you click on content exclusively reserved for registered attendees, the site will prompt you to log-in. Your credentials are the same as for the ACOS website.


## CME CREDIT CLAIMING:


- 1) If you are not already logged in, click *Login* at the top of the screen and enter your ACOS website username and password. After logging in click, the *Claim Your CME* button.












- 3) Once you have completed claiming CME credit for the sessions you attended, refer to the CME Evaluation site for instructions on finishing the process by
