EDUCATIONAL ACCESS | CME CREDIT CLAIMING

Instructions to access the 2022 Annual Clinical Assembly (ACA) educational video content and to claim continuing medical education (CME) credit commensurate with participation in the activity.

EDUCATIONAL ACCESS:

- 1) Visit the 2022 Annual Clinical Assembly website at: <u>https://www.eventscribe.net/2022/ACA/</u>
- 2) Click *Login* at the top of the screen and enter your ACOS website username and password. After logging in click *Full Schedule* to browse the program.



3) After logging in you will have access to available 2022 ACA session videos. To view the ACA lectures from the homepage of the ACA site, click on the *Full Schedule*. This will take you to the catalog of all the sessions for the 2022 ACA.

HELP TIP: Make sure you are logged in. This is confirmed by seeing your name in the upper righthand corner of the screen. If not logged in, when you click on content exclusively reserved for registered attendees, the site will prompt you to log-in. Your credentials are the same as for the ACOS website.
