Laboratory fees increase July 11. The last day to register for a laboratory is August 24. ACVS reserves the right to cancel any laboratory that does not meet minimum registrations by August 24. If the laboratory is canceled by this date, registrants will be notified via email no later than August 31, and all paid registration fees will be refunded.

Registrants for laboratories are advised not to make airline and hotel reservations until after August 31, to ensure their selected laboratory is not canceled. ACVS will not reimburse for travel in the case of a cancellation due to low registrations.
