Checklist: Do I need permission to use this table/image?

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- Is it from a published journal, book, or website? → Permission usually needed.
 Check the publisher's policy.
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General best practice:

- Give credit on the slide (e.g., "Source: Smith et al., 2024, Journal of Diabetes Care")
- When in doubt, get permission.
