


Student & Resident Poster Submissions

- Include the poster presenters – those who will be in attendance should they be accepted to present
- Indicate non-presenting co-authors: those worked on the project, but won't be in attendance
- An option to upload any graphics, tables, or files
- Learning Outcomes from the poster
- Submit a submission agreement
- Answer a few questions about the paper/abstract and if it's been presented before or funded by AOPA – and just a commitment that if accepted, they plan to attend.


