Priority Topics for 2023

The ASAM Annual Conference Program Planning Committee has identified priority topics for inclusion in this year's conference based on attendee feedback, trends in the field, and identified learner needs. Submissions on these topics are strongly encouraged.

Clinical Topics:

- Aging populations (Overall and specifically African American with other physical co-morbidities)
- Cannabis use and cannabis use in special populations (eg, adolescents, chronic pain patients)
- Chronic pain (overall and specifically buprenorphine for chronic pain)
- Contingency Management (overall and reimbursement specific)
- Digital therapeutics
- Fentanyl
- Gambling addiction
- Harm reduction
- Induction, low-dose induction, and precipitated withdrawal
- Inpatient and outpatient alcohol withdrawal management
- Nicotine/Tobacco
- Patients in the corrections/criminal legal system
- Pregnant/parenting patients
- Protocol development/implementation and process improvement
- Psychosocial interventions
- Sexual/gender minority populations
- Stimulant use disorder medications
- Sedatives, Benzodiazepines
- Psychedelics for Therapeutic Use
