## 2022 Children's Healthcare Canada Award for Patient & Family Leadership Call for Nominations

## **Award Description**

The Children's Healthcare Canada **Award for Patient & Family Leadership** was created to recognize outstanding leadership by a patient (current or former), parent or caregiver who has served to improve the patient and family experience for those accessing pediatric health care in Canada.

## **Nomination Terms**

- Nominees must be a patient (current or former), parent or caregiver of a child who has received services at a Children's Healthcare Canada member organization.
- The nomination must be submitted through the online nomination form no later than July 15, 2022.
- The nominee must consent to the nomination.
- Individuals are invited to self-nominate or they may be nominated by a representative from a Children's Healthcare Canada member organization.
- The Children's Healthcare Canada Awards Selection Committee Directors shall adjudicate the nominations and the awardee will be notified, via email, in late September.
- The recipient of this award will receive one complimentary registration to the 2022 Children's Healthcare Canada's Annual Conference.

- The awardee is expected to attend the Annual Children's Healthcare Canada Awards Ceremony on November 30, 2022, in Ottawa, Ontario to accept this award.
- The award recipient is expected to record a 4–6-minute video that will be published to the Children's Healthcare Canada website following the Awards Ceremony on November 30, 2022.
