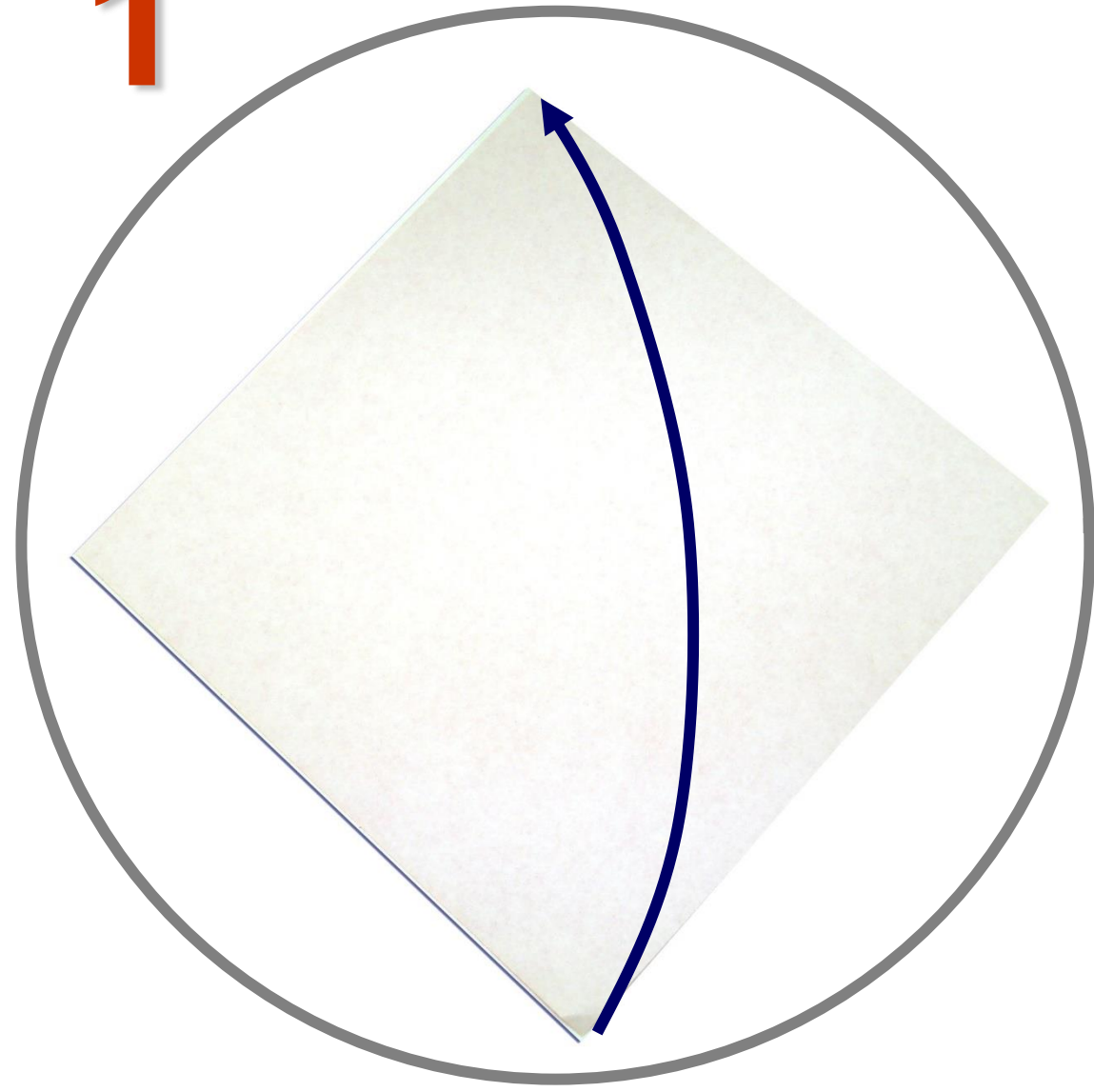


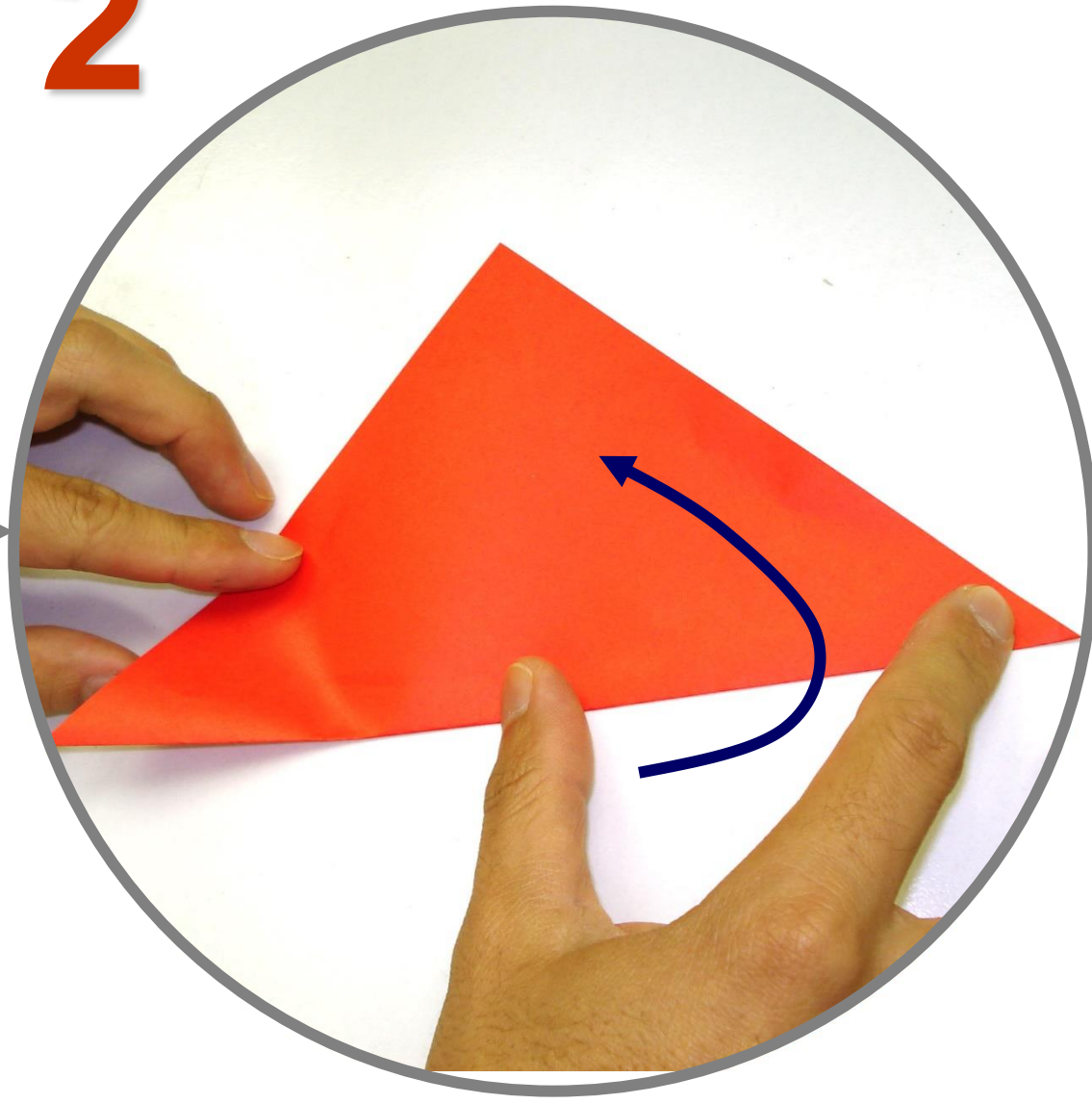
# ORIGAMI BUTTERFLY

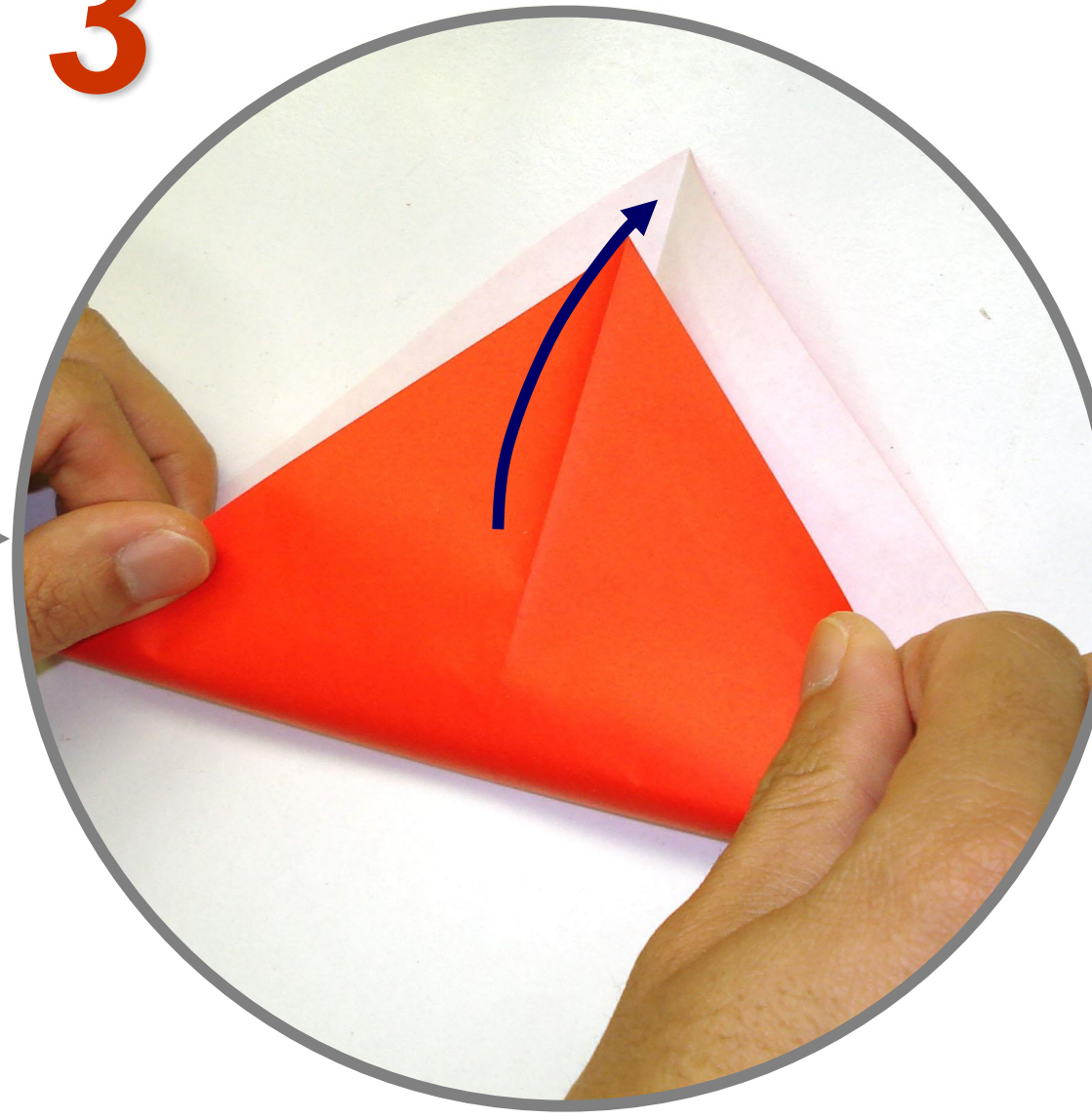
**Start with white-side up.

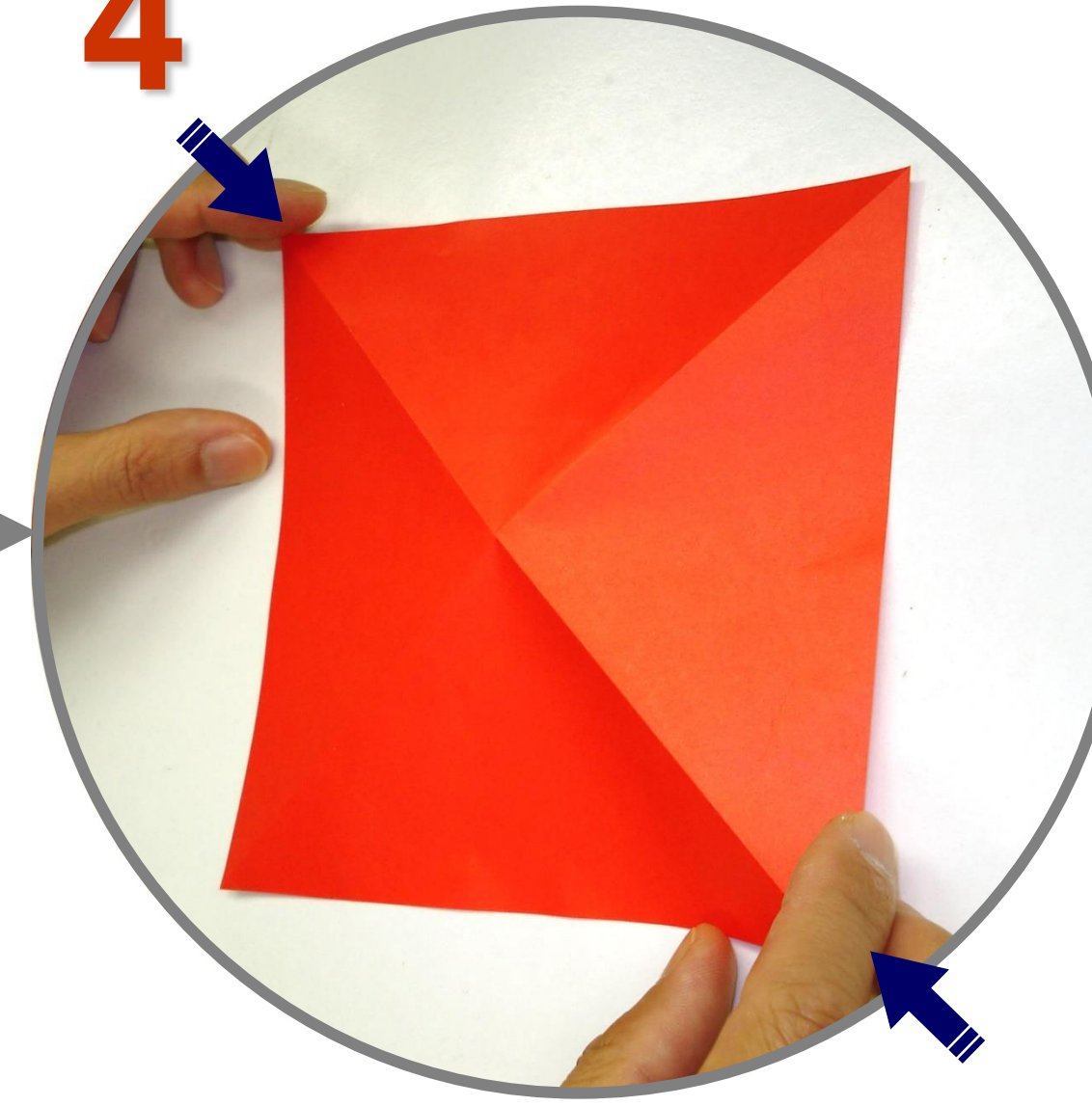
**Turn the paper 90 degrees.

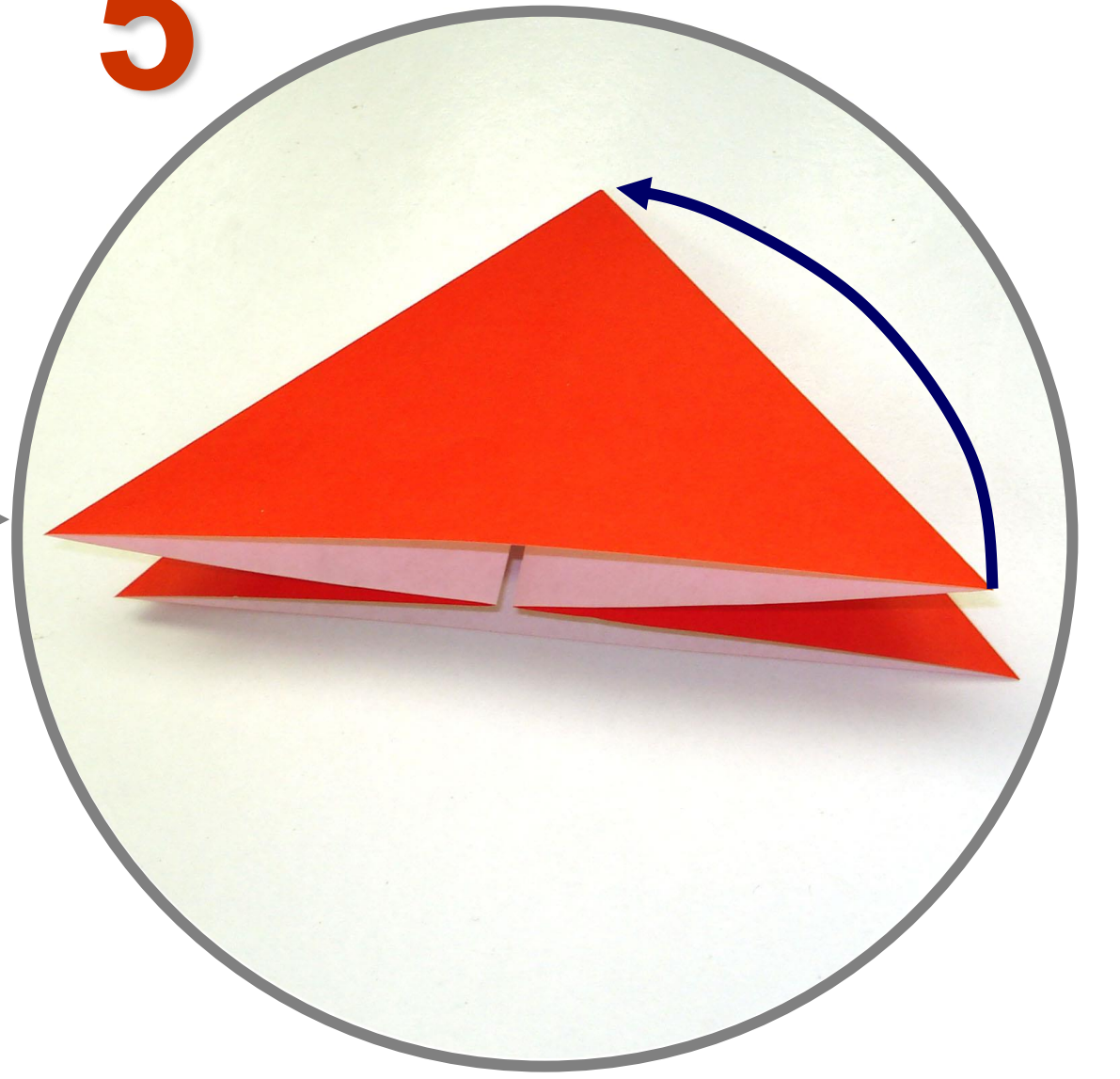
**Fold diagonally again.

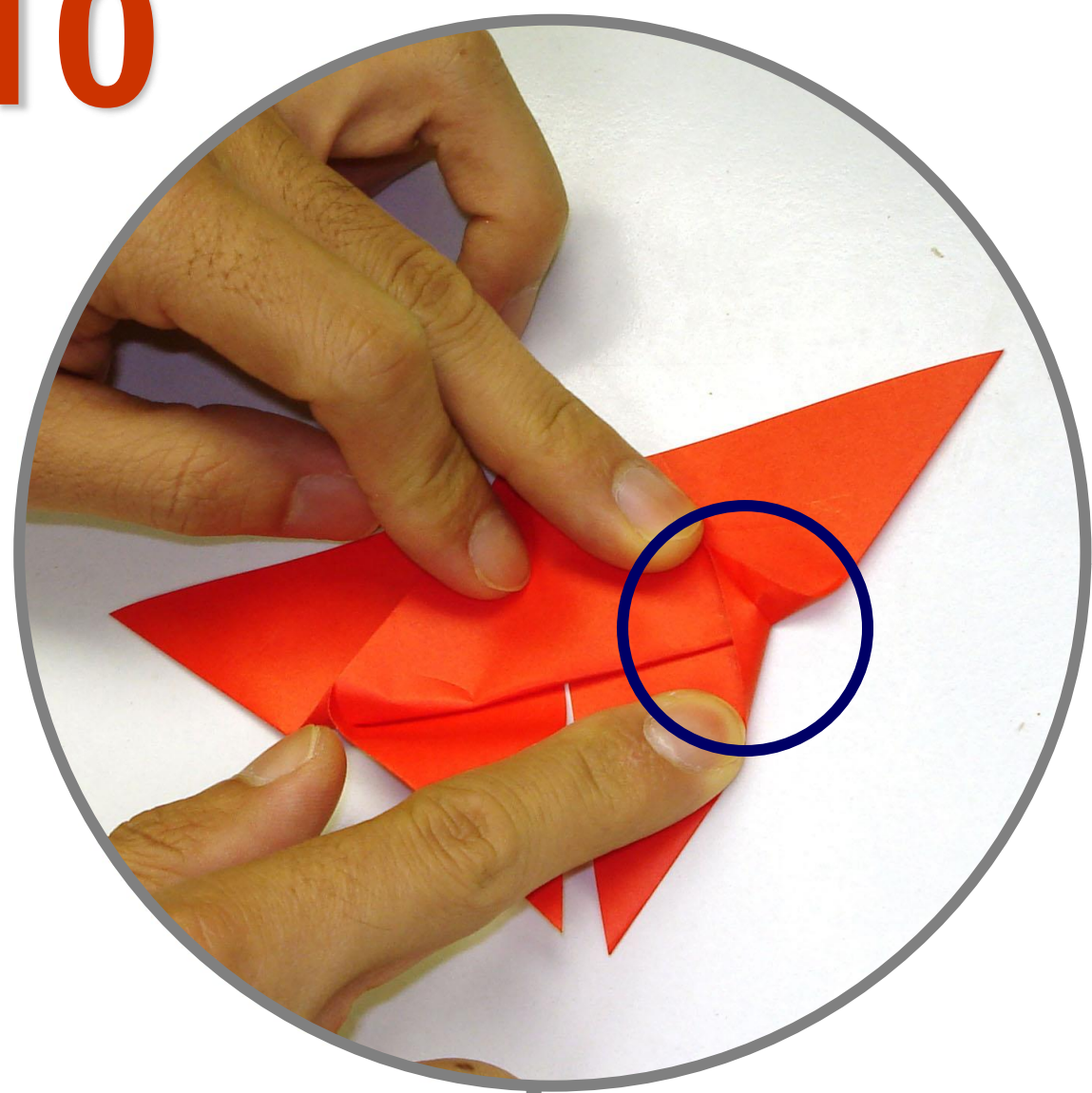
**Push two points inward to make

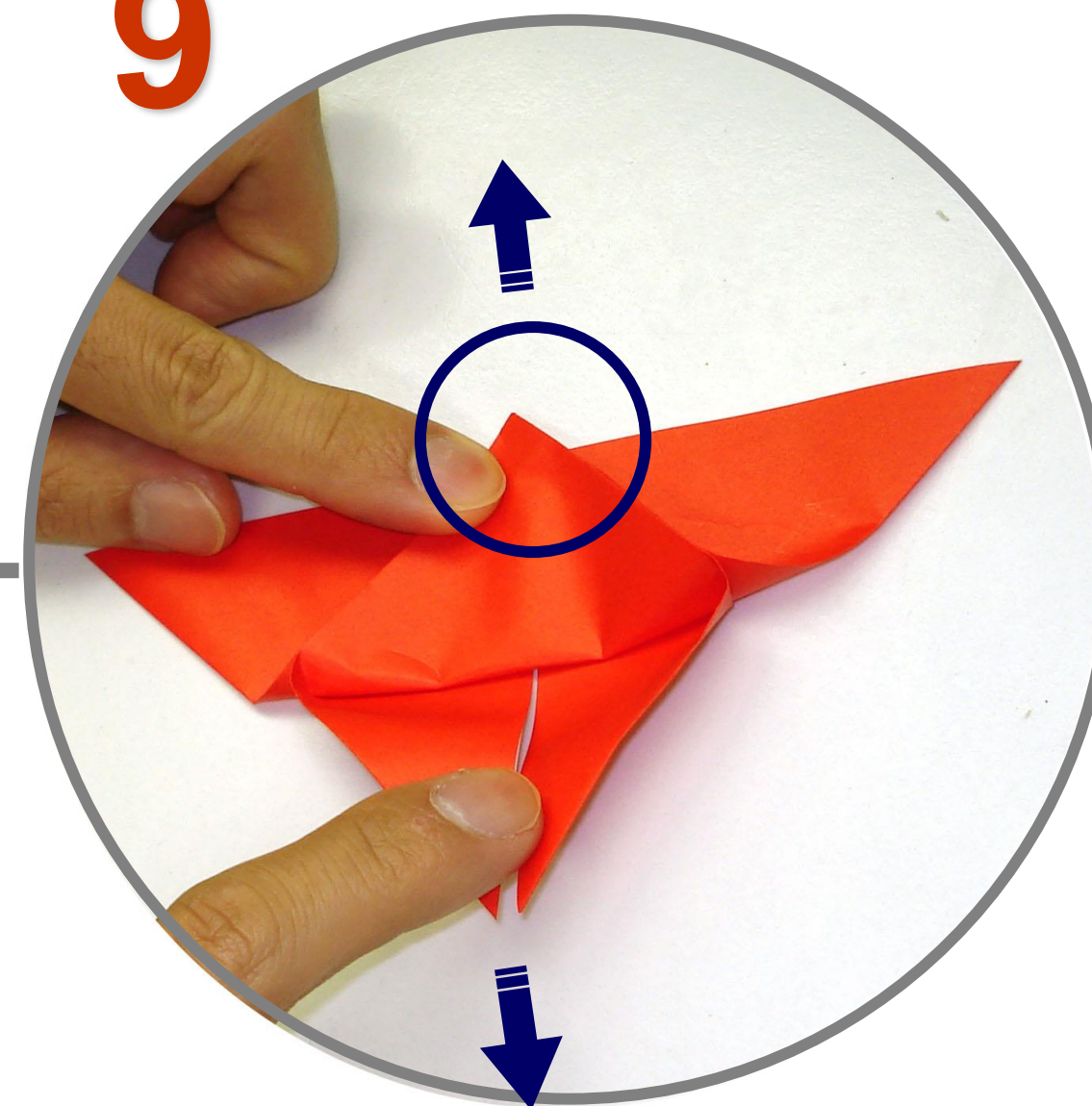


**Take one corner and

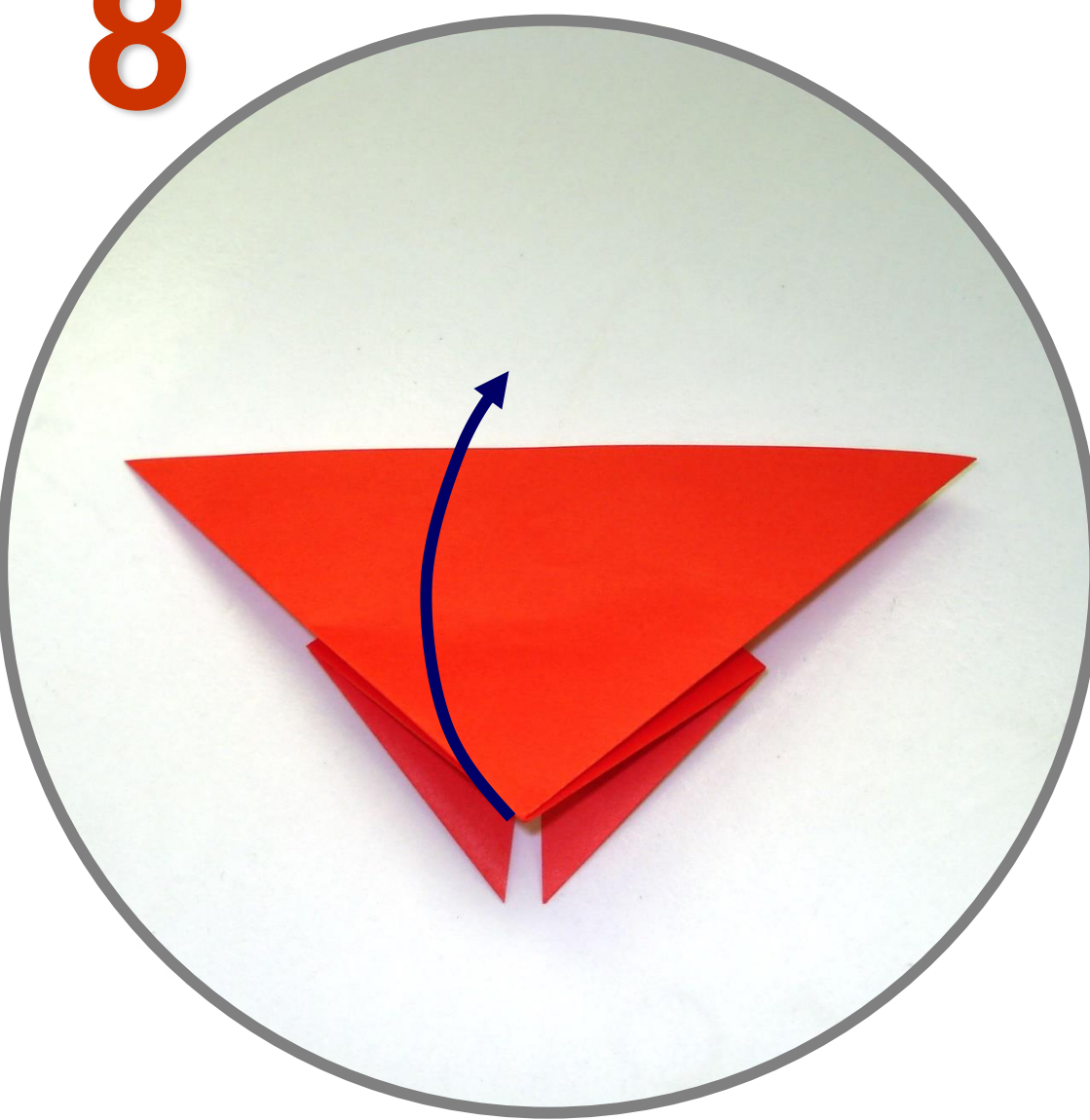

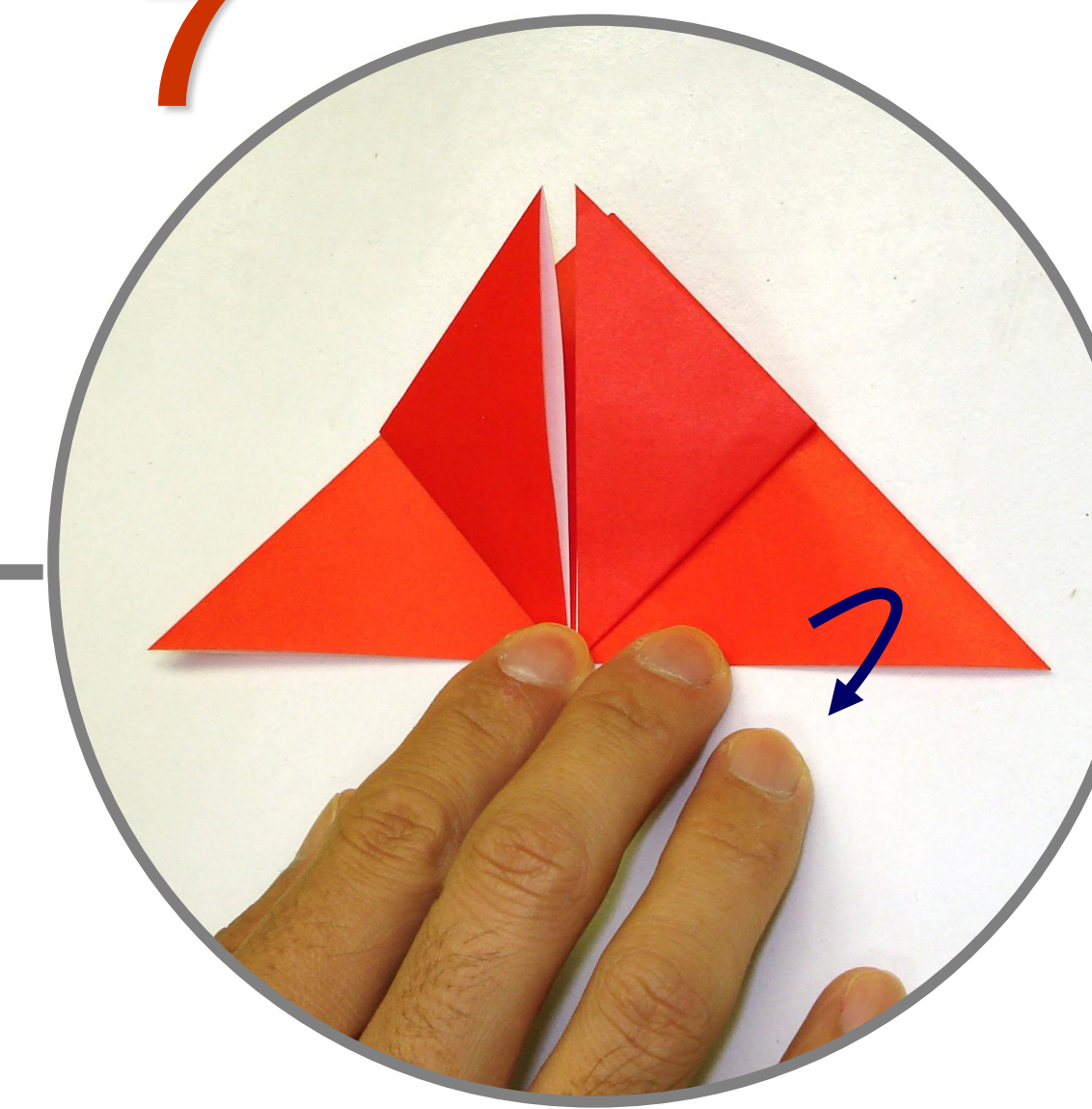
**Spread the paper.

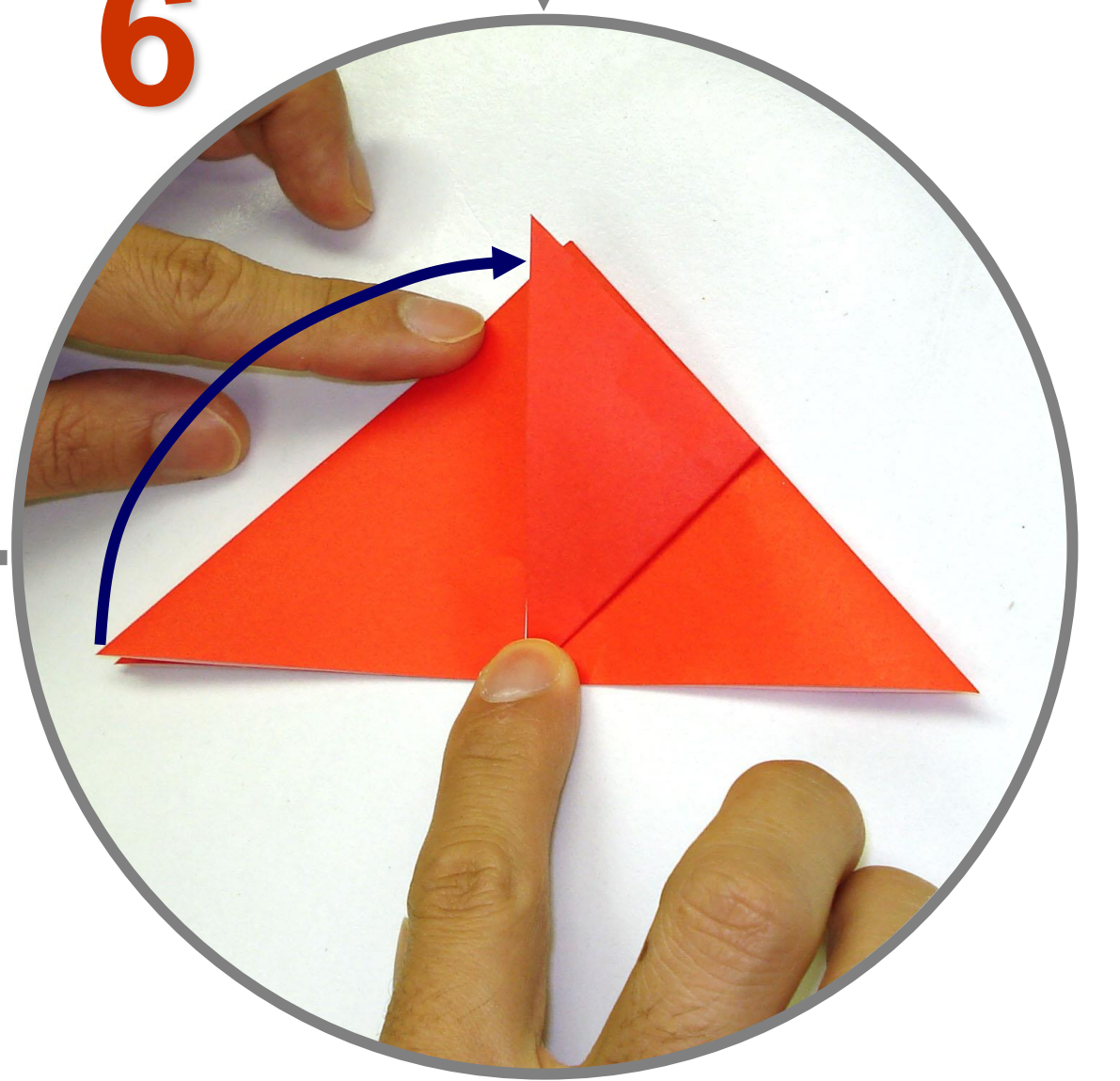
**Fold the point to the top.

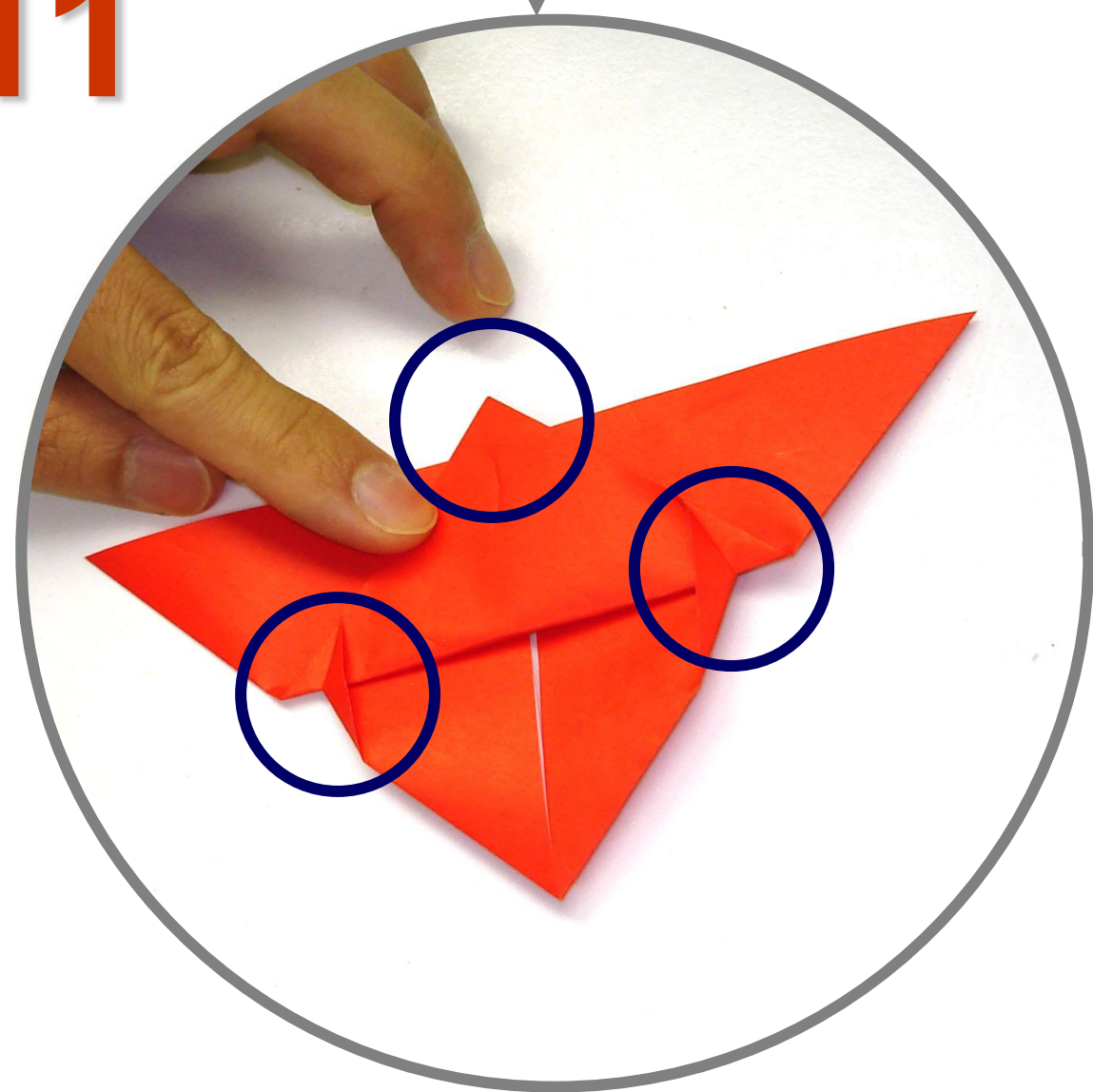
**Turn the paper 180 degrees.**

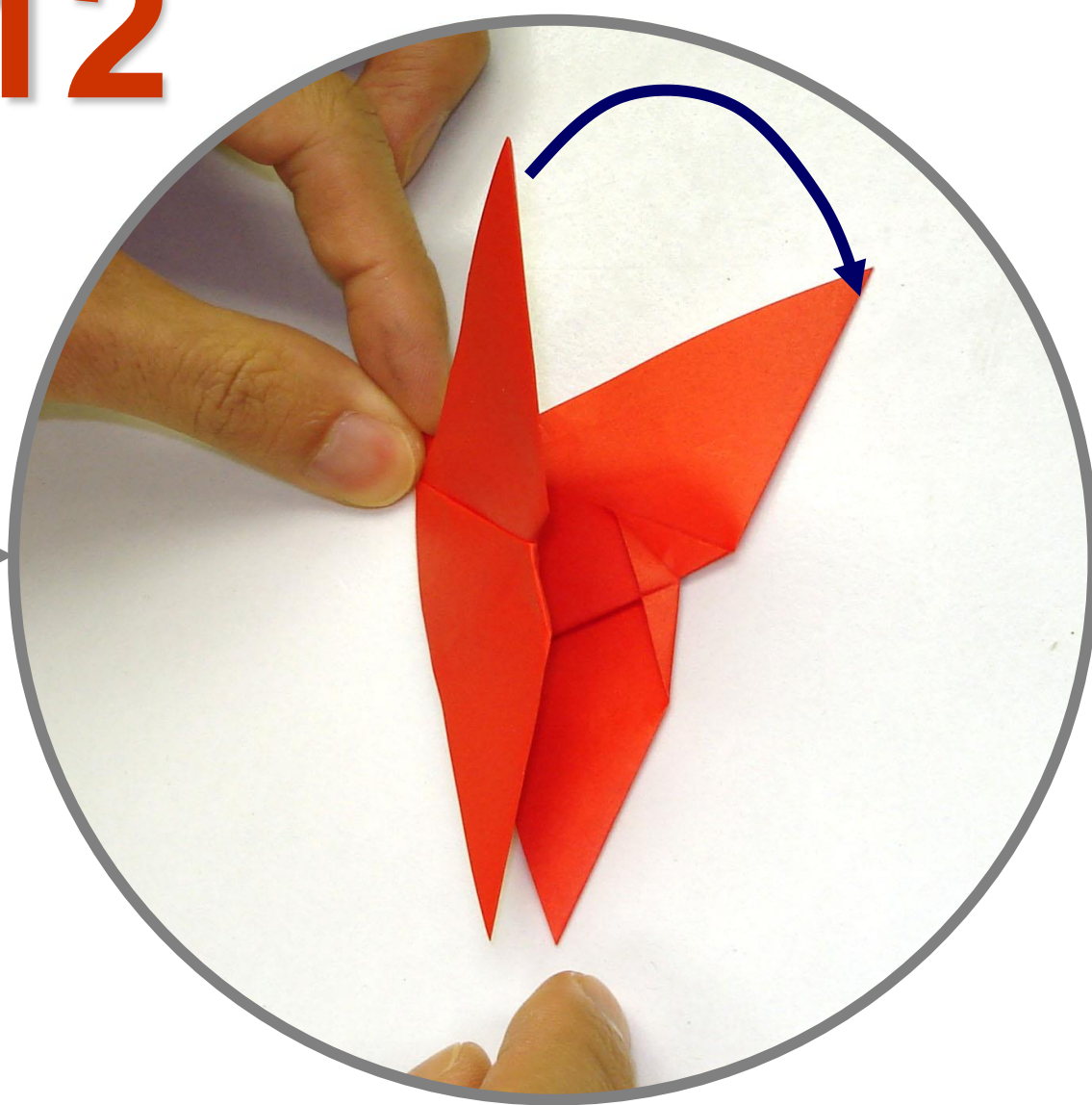
**Repeat it on the left side.**

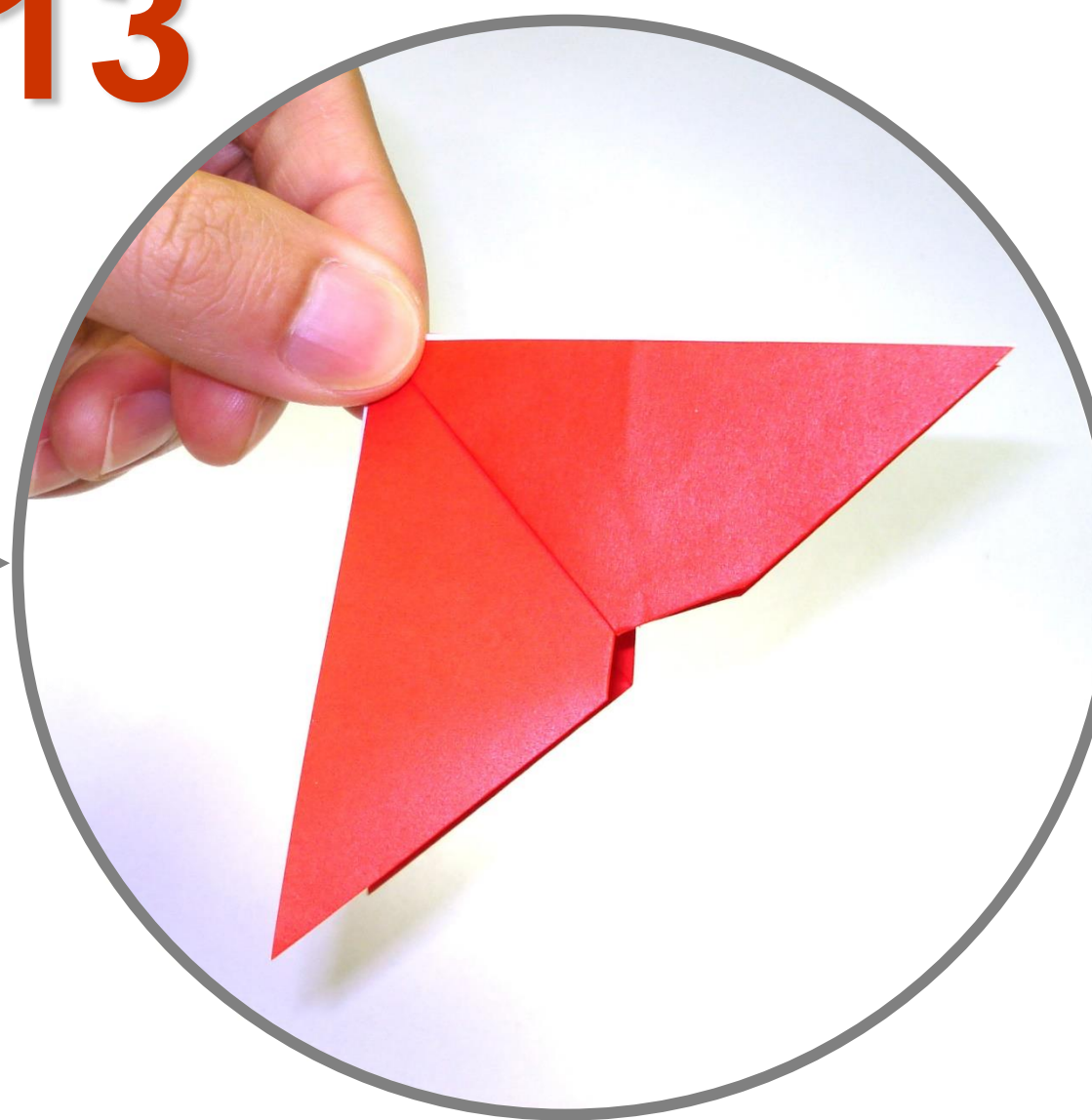
**Make sure these parts

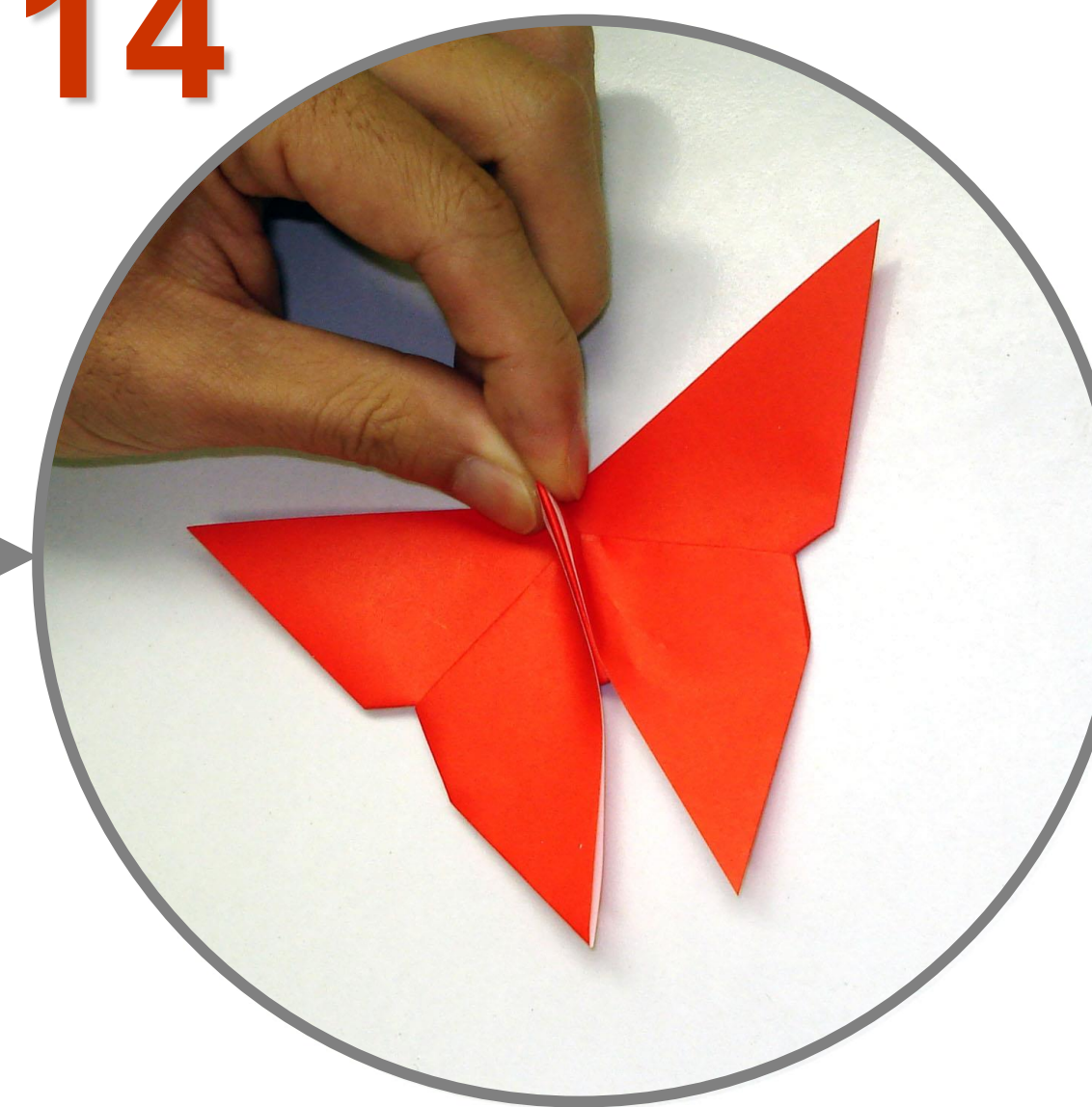
**Fold in half to the right.**

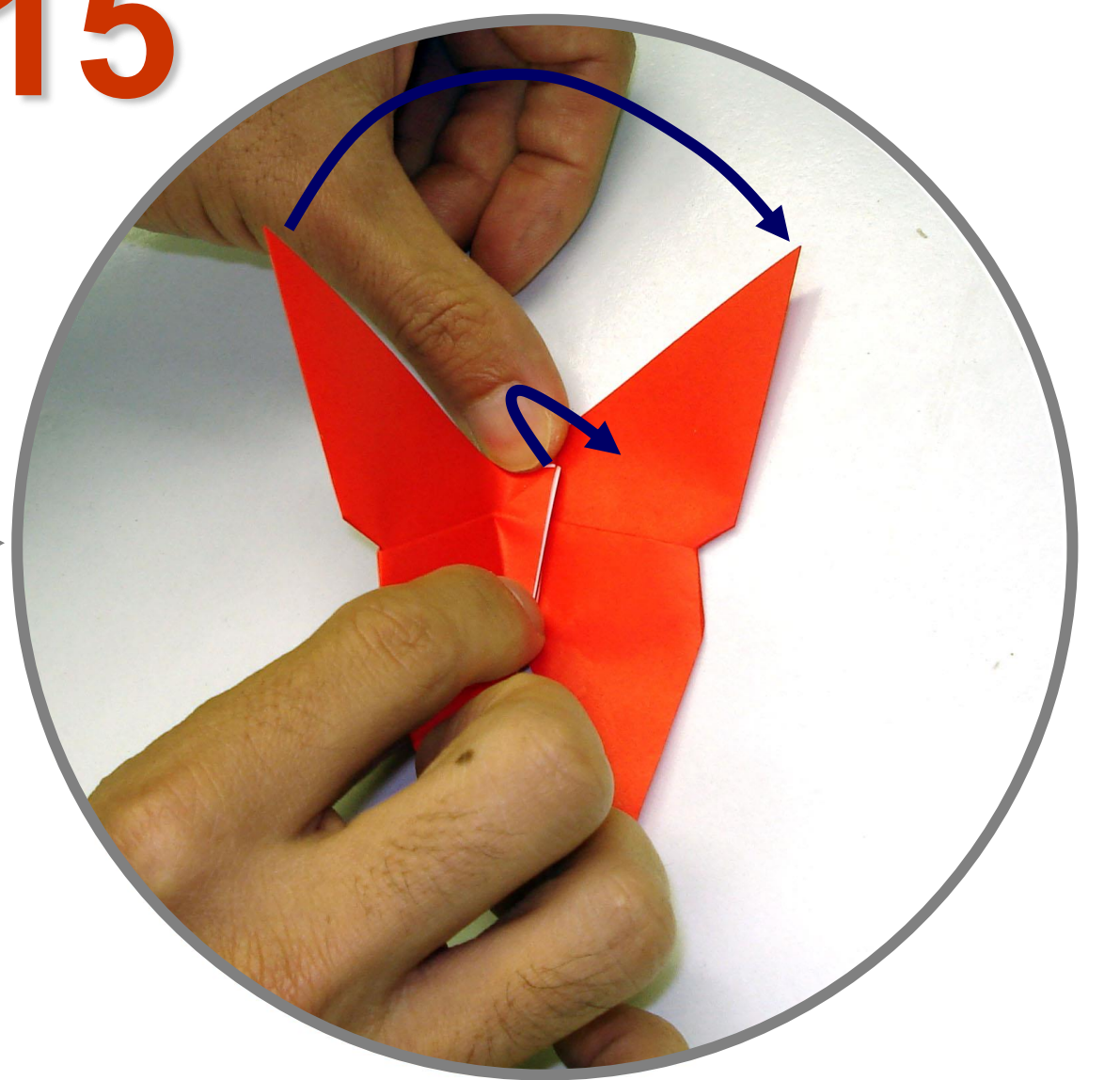
**Grab the head.**
